**MINOR PUPPY DOG (1):** 1. Nash's JALFREZI RED HOT 7 months r/r cobby type, co-ordinated side profile mover, still looks very young, promise of a good coat, largish head, good stop and width to chin. Needs to get ears under control.

**PUPPY DOG (3,2a):** 1. Thompson's TREMALOY SON OF A GUN, scopy, active and alert, typy r/r, 11 months, pleasing head, good skull, well open nostrils, good bite, good size even teeth, neat ears, good expression, medium neck, good body, well sprung ribs, when concentrating moved well.

**JUNIOR DOG (7):** 1. Rundle's SALORA HI FIDELITY, compact, sturdy b/t/s, level even mouth, good head profile, deep stop, wide muzzle, small well set ears, pleasing bone, level topline, deep well spring rib, moved efficiently; 2. Smith's BEAUVIEW I CAN HEAR THUNDER, quality b/t/s, good markings, pleasing head, good open nostrils, good breadth of chest, showy and fluid mover; Conways STORMJAC DUTCH CAN CAN COOP.

**YEARLING DOG (4,1a):** Spittle & Hewitt's RHODON CAPTAIN SCARLET compact, smart r/s, short thick coat, standing foursquare, pleasing head qualities, fluid mover, good bone and ribs, showed very well; 2. B I Can Hear Thunder; 3. Carpenter's Klansted Harvest Moon.

**POST GRADUATE DOG (5,2a):** 1. Graay's ASTIROK A TALE TO TELL OF OKAMI, mature typy r/r, good appeal, co-ordinated, sound efficient mover, good size coat of good quality, good lay of shoulder and return of upper arm, masculine head, width to underjaw, tail set on well; 2. K HARVEST MOON, showing better, compact, solid r/s, fair neck, happy mover, quite square in outline.; 3. Aprick Edoras at Cilleine.

**LIMIT DOG (6,3a):** 1. Spurr's SANTARRA HIGHLANDER FOR SUTTONELMS, litter brother to BIS, mature, well headed r/r, appealing for overall type, good head shape, large expressive eye, level teeth in jaw, good tuck up of chin, neat ears, well bodied, good spring of rib; 2. Ogden's CHARKA BLACK UNISON, compact, stylish b/t/r of quality, large head, big expressive eyes,, very well developed in body qualities, deep chest, showed well; 3. Higgin's JAYDEAN DENZIL BLACK.

**SP OPEN BLACK DOG (2):** 1. J Denzil Black, square, compact black, most appealing head, large round dark eye, wide open nostrils, good bite, prominent chin, neat ear, well bodied, standing on good feet, really got into his stride, strong coat texture; 3. S Dutchman Can Can Coop, compact much younger black,pleasing outline, attractive head, good mouth. Feeling better about himself now.

**Sp OPEN B/T DOG (3):** 1. Thompson's BEAUVIEW TROOP THE COLOUR, good size, well prepared b/t, compact & smart in outline, well developed body and hindquarters which he drives from, masculine head, good jaw, open nostrils, good topline; 2. B I Can Hear Thunder.

**Sp OPEN RED DOG (5,2a):** 1. Barney's SANTARRA SALSA TO CILLEINE, mature stylish but still correct well made type r/r, pleasing large head, generous eye, good expression, bite and turn up to chin, very well balanced forequarters, very sound movement, well muscled hindquarters, lowest hocks, free movement with good drive from rear, true coming and going, well put together body, in good coat, really looked the part **CC & BIS** this made him up; 2. White's CH CILLEINE STRATHSPEY OVER WISTLEYHILL, 5 yrs r/s, square outline, free fluid mover. Not the head qualities of 1 but overall good body shape; 3. IR CH ORLOCK HOT AS HELL WITH LATOUR.

**OPEN DOG (5,1a):** 1. Mercer's CH FENNYMORE PINKIE ROYALE, r/r upstanding smart, well headed dog, deep stop, open nostrils, small ear, well developed body in good coat **RCC**; 2. Price's CH MARQUANT MY ROMEO very appealing young rich r/r, very well prepared, compact and cobby, good head and expression, level topline; 3. Tomlinson's CH DEBMAR WHISKY MAC AT MIRROYS.

**VETERAN DOG (2,1a):** 1. Carpenter's GAYSTOCK LE BOURBON, quality dog, rising 9, good head, large eye, good nose pad, moved steadily and well, pleasing overall type,

**MINOR PUPPY BITCH (3,1a)** 1. Corrigan's BEAUVIEW BANANARAMA, 7 months r/r most appealing, square outline, fair reach of neck, well laid shoulders, well angulated hindquarters, good set of tail and carriage, moved freely, stylish puppy; 2. Rose's RHODON REGAL MAID type, very happy r/s, good overall shape, showing for all she was worth. A little happy with her front.

**PUPPY BITCH (5,2a):** 1. Ogden's BEAUVIEW FLY THE FLAG , very smart correctly built b/t, very square in outline, level topline, neat hindquarters, open nostrils, good wide muzzle and turn up of chin, co-ordinated on the move, very bright prospect; 2. Suggit's APTRICK GILTONIEL, r/r not as compact as 1, but still a lot to like. Well bodied, large dark eye, open nostrils, grand coat; 3. Harvey's EMIRARAE'S KEZIAH.

**JUNIOR BITCH (9,1a):** Quality class. 1. Owen's SANTARRA DORA THE EXPLORER, very typical, unexaggerated, sound moving, well balanced r/r, pleasing feminine head. Good finish to jaw, in great coat, well bodied, good tailset and carriage; 2. Thompson's TREMALOY ONE OF THE TROOPS , balanced free moving rr/r, good finish to jaw, open nostrils, good body, . Not as compact as 1; 3. Barney's CILLEINE ANOTHER DAY.

**YEARLING BITCH (4,1a):** 1. Conway's STORMJAC DUTCH BE-BOP BETTY, balanced r/r up to size, large head, large expressive dark eyes, fair neck, well laid shoulders, deep well ribbed body, pleasing hindquarters and tailset, moves collectively and soundly; 2. Streeter's ROAMAYCEE CRACKLIN ROSIE r/s compact neck, dark red shortish coat, good outline, free mover,, balanced, good feet; 3. Corrigan's BEAUVIEW DO NOT ASK.

**POST GRADUATE BITCH (10):** 1. Willsmer's GAYSTOCK JUST SO, smartly turned out, generous headed r/r, pleasing outline, steady true mover, expressive head, good bite, fair neck, well laid shoulders & return of upper arm, neat hindquarters **RCC**; 2. Nash's BEAUVIEW NOT BOTHERED quality r/r, not in the best of coats, overall quality was there for all to see, well balanced, good front assembly, moved soundly and well. Perhaps carrying a little too much weight. Typical head; 3. Scott's JAYDEAN BLACK PETAL OF SAMARANDA.

**LIMIT BITCH (10)** 1. Scott's SAMARANDA TAYLORS MAID. squarely built, beautifully headed, large round dark lustrous eyes, wide open nostrils, good finish to jaw, neat well placed ears, good front assembly, well developed deep chest, ribbed body, moved efficiently and soundly; 2. Owen's SANTARRA LILLIE LAMPLITE , mature r/r, typically good overall shape. Between coats but outline there for all to see; 3. Chapman's CILLEINE SHUVANI.

**Sp OPEN BLACK BITCH (7,3a):** 1. Price's MARQUANT ULTRA VIOLET, ultra smart compact efficient moving b/r, very good head, neat ears, generous eye, good finish to jaw, crested neck, good front assembly, good chest, strong well knit body, moving from strong hindquarters. Not large by any means but a little dynamo, **CC**; 2. Scott's Jaydean Kiss Me Kate at Samaranda, quality b/r built on good lines, moves around the ring well. Overhadowed by 1; 3. Suggit's Aprick Minas Tirith.

**Sp OPEN B/T BITCH (2,1a):** 1. Ogden's BEAUVIEW SPOT CHECK, very smart, lovely front assembly, good neck and lay of shoulder, level topline, good hindquarters, feminine head, good expression, fluid mover.

**Sp OPEN RED BITCH (3):** 1. Barney's Ch Cilleine Imagine Sternroc, rich r/s, stylish fluid movement, level topline, well developed body, very nicely made behind, good tailset and carriage, head good; 2. Rose's RHODON REGINA, neatly made r/s, good neck & front assembly, happy mover; 3. Millbone's CHERRY BLOSSOM AT MIRA .

**OPEN BITCH (3,1a):** 1. Price's CH MARQUANT THE DREAM GIRL, mature b/r, put down to the 'tee', generous feminine head, large dark round eye, good nose placement, good chin, fair crested neck, well laid shoulders, level topline, good coat for colour and texture, well made hindquarters & tailset; 2. White's FENNYMORE CARAMEL CRUNCH OF WISTLEYHILL, r/s, good overall balance & style. Not quite the head of 1.

**VETERAN BITCH (8,1a):** 1. Owen's CILLEINE CRIANZA AT SANTARRA, mother of BIS winbner, efficient moving r/s, built on square lines, good neck and shoulder, deep chest, well sprung rib, good topline; 2. Carpenter's GAYSTOCK LA MARIE, 9 yrs r/r, large expressive head, dark eye, wide open nostrils, compact body, moved well, sister to VD winner; 3. Barney's CH BROOMLEAF BEGUINE OF CILLEINE.

**PROGENY (3,1a):** 1. Ogden's BEAUVIEW OUT OF THE CLOSET, both groups had a lot to commend them and both certainly a credit to their breeder, felt this group had more consistency. Out of The Closet was responsible for many placings.
