I would like to thank the committee for their kind invitation and the opportunity to do my first Championship show. My thanks to my ring stewards Aiken Johnson and Caroline Prout. I have been interested in this breed for 25 years and it was breathtaking to see the improvement in the b/t colour in type and more uniformity in size.

MPD (4,1): 1. Corrigan's Catdanse Dennise the Menace bt/r 6 months old puppy with attitude, good head with small nicely carried ears, compact well balanced level topline, great body shape for age with tail nicely set on. **BPIS** congratulations.

2. Goldin's Fleetgold Horrible Horace bt/r nice head, well carried ears, large dark eyes, good turnup and width of jaw, rich colour and harsh coat, with tail carried well, good in profile. 3. Ogden's Beauview I Can Hear Thunder.

PD (1): 1. Catdanse Dennis the Menace.

JD (1): 1. Laidlaw & Cook's Roamaycee Double Take r/s 16 month old, has an attractive head, well carried ears, good turnup and width of jaw, lovely expression. Nice neck and shoulders, short coupled. Short tight smooth coat, rich colour. Good fore and aft, tail well set on.

ND (1): 1. Beauview I Can Hear Thunder bt/r in the minor puppy class. Good top of head, well carried ears, dark eyes. Pleasing outline, good texture of coat and colour.

GD (1): 1. Duncan's Rhodon Sunny Jim r/s. Lovely typy head, well carried ears, good turnup, nice profile, needs to settle on the move.

LD (2): 1. Hateley's Gilderoak Feel Free To Settle r/r with large masculine head, good nose placement, lovely expression, neat well carried ears. Good body with good spring of rib, covered the ground well going round the ring. 2. Swinge's Balthazar Got The Hots 4 years old r/r, small dog who is well proportioned, attractive head with well carried ears, short of coat. Nice breed type, moved well.

OD (5,2): 1. Guy's Ch Donzeata Royal Vintage, 4.5 year old r/r is well balanced, everything is where it should be, masculine classic head, lovely eye and nose placement, good neck and shoulders. Beautiful profile, lovely topline and tailset. Has great ring presence. Reminded me of the Starbecks. **DCC & BIS** – congratulations.

2. Moore & Connery's Ch/ Ir & Int Ch Santarra Swing to Cilleine ShCM 4 year old r/r, large masculine head, good turnup and width of jaw, dark eyes, well carried ears. Good front assembly, level topline holding it on the move, driving well from behind, beautifully presented. My winner was just a bit more compact RDCC. 3. Ogden's Charka Black Unison 4 years old bt/r with tail nicely carried, real masculine head, good turnup and width of jaw, dark eyes, well carried ears. Moderate neck, level topline, depth of brisket. A real asset to this colour.

SpO R/S D (1): 1. Guy's Ch Donzeata Royal Double r/s rich red colour, good tight coat. Lovely head, neat well carried ears, nice in profile, lovely breed type, gave his handler a hard time.

SpO R/R D (2,1): Swinge's Beauview Hot Gossip ShCM 4 year old r/r smallish dog who is well proportioned, has an attractive head with well carried ears, good front, excellent breed type.

SpO Black D (1): Higgin's Jaydean Denzil Black b/r in excellent coat and condition, good head and turn up, width of jaw. Firm body, level topline, moved well.

SpO B/T D (2): 1. Thompson's Beauview Troop The Colour bt/r. Beautiful breed type, large head, dark, round eyes, gleaming condition, nice in profile, unfortunately not moving well.

VD (1): 1. Wren's Renshaw Red Alert r/s. Nice breed type, typical head, neat well carried ears, dark round eyes, some frosting on his muzzle, correct tight coat. Holding topline on the move, well set-on tail.

SpVintage B (5,2): 1. Wren's Donzeata Royal Romance 10.5 year old r/r, good head with nicely carried small ears, round dark eye, short and compact, level topline holding it on the move, good tail set, really enjoying her day out. **BVIS** – congratulations. 2. Swinge's Ch Marquant Saffron r/r classic head, good turnup and dark eye, ample neck, level topline, straight front, rather short of coat today.

3. Rose's Rhodon Flo Black.

MPB (3,1): 1. Ogden's Roamaycee Cracklin Rosie, quality 8.5 months r/s with good rich colour and tight coat, nice top of head, well carried small neat ears, large round dark eyes, good turnup. Lovely in profile, level topline holding it on the move with tail correctly carried BPB. 2. Simpson & Bagshaw's Nosygriff Summer Wine 7.5 month old r/s, sturdier type, nice head, neck, level topline. Good width of chest and depth of brisket, not very happy today.

PB (2): 1. Thompson's Beauview Do Not Ask r/r 10 month old, coat needs to clear. Good head, ears need to settle, dark eyes, would like more underjaw. Nice body shape, level topline, enjoying her day out. 2. Lee's Fleetgold Tickled Pink b/t, good top of head with nicely carried ears, large dark eyes. Good body shape, low tailset, needs to settle on the move.

JB (3): 1. Ogden's Beauview Bounced Cheque, bt/s with gleaming coat, this madam has character, good head with nicely carried ears and ample turnup. Lovely in profile, shows with tail well carried, good depth of brisket, moved well both coming and going. 2. Moore & Connery's Cilleine There's A Place At Cicely, well made r/s with richly coloured tight coat, different type. Large head, well carried ears, good width of jaw, neck going into well laid shoulders, level topline. Very useful type of bitch.

Laidlaw & Cook's Roamaycee Mines A Double.

NB (5,2): 1. Finlay's Fennymore Fudge Donut at Gilderoak r/r 11 months, typical head, nicely carried ears, dark eyes, liked her outline and body shape, nicely carried tail, lovely moving in profile, good breed type. 2. Nosygriff Summer Wine.

3. Fleetgold Tickled Pink.

GB (4,2): 1. Nelson's Blingbling Highland Fling r/r classic head with well carried ears, round eyes, good turnup, large nose pad. Lovely breed type, good depth of body, tail well set on. 2. Fennymore Fudge Donut at Gilderoak.

PGB (4,2): 1. Nelson's Blingbling Red Label r/r litter sister to my previous class winner, very similar type, old fashioned large head, nice ears. Short and cobby, lovely body shape, good depth of brisket. 2. Rose's Rhodon Miss Chief r/s typical head with neat well carried ears, large dark eyes, a good turnup. Nice outline, straight front, nice feet.

LB (4,1): 1. Swinge's Balthazar Hot Stuff r/r good breed type, correct head, ears well carried, nice eye, good neck and shoulders, rather short of coat today. 2. Courtney's Donzeata Royal Sensation to Philcourt r/s, bright red jacket, nice head with neat ears, good turnout and width of jaw, firm body. Nice type. 3. Corrigan's Beauview Dish The Dirt.

OB (3,2): 1. Scott's Samaranda Taylor Maid b/r harsh black coat of good colour. Lovely head, front, neck and shoulders. Well put together, nice tail carriage.

SpO R/S B (5,2): 1. Rose's Jaydean Miss Teak at Rhodon r/s correct head and expression, good front and tight feet, nice rich colour. Level topline and good depth of body. 2. Donzeata Royal Sensation at Philcourt. 3. Beauview Dish The Dirt.

SpO R/R B (2,1): 1. Swinge's Beauview Not One To Gossip r/r ultra feminine, lovely head and expression, smallest of ears, straight front, grand body shape, short and very compact RBCC.

SpO Black B (2,1): 1. Higgin's Ch Jaydean Lena Horne 6.5 year old b/r in cracking form, harsh black coat in excellent condition. Good head, nicely carried ears, dark eyes. Nice in profile and balanced, well set on tail **BCC & RBIS** – congratulations.

SpO B/T B (5,2): 1. Goldin's Fleetgold The Beansprout b/t s excellent breed type, good head with small ears, lovely dark eye, good turnout, carrying too much weight. 2. Fleetgold Tickled Pink. 3. Goldin's Fleetgold Thursday Next.
